Biography

Pieter Telleman was born in 1965 in The Netherlands where he received a Chemical Engineering degree, a M.Sc. degree in Biochemistry, and a Ph.D. degree in Medicine. After his PhD he joined the Harvard University where he assumed fellowships in applying micro-and nanotechnology to life sciences. Pieter joined the Department of Micro- and Nanotechnology at the Technical University of Denmark (DTU) as group leader of the Bio/Chemical Microsystems Group. He subsequently assumed the position of director of the department.
